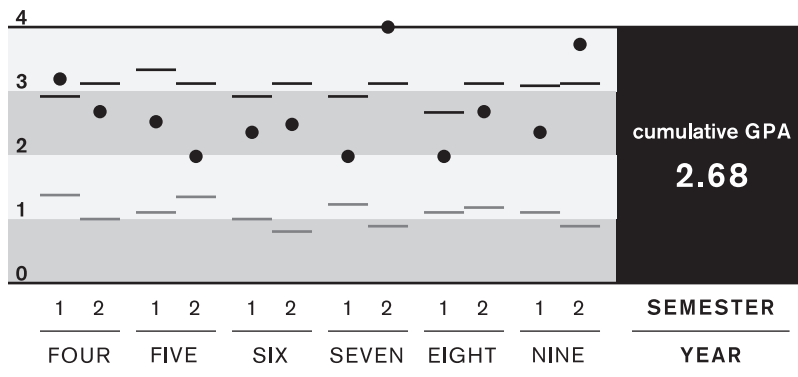

THE STAGES OF COGNITIVE DEVELOPMENT

Cognitive development research focuses on the mental structures of individuals—schemes used to understand the world, organize knowledge and provide for future learning. Progress can be used for detailed analysis of an individual's gains from education.

PREOPERATIONAL	2-7
CONCRETE OPERATIONAL	7-11
FORMAL OPERATIONAL	11+

FORMAL OPERATIONAL STAGE—[4 OF 4]

Beginning with puberty, this stage is characterized by acquisition of the ability to think abstractly.

Physiology: the study of the mechanical, physical, and biochemical functions of living organisms.

Cognition: an information processing view of an individual's psychological functions

Ethical Judgement: analysis and employment of concepts such as right and wrong, good and evil, and responsibility
